Trained pups go to their new homes at 7 months once their training is complete. A certified professional dog trainer will train the puppy by using science based training methods and positive reinforcement. The puppy will also be taught by assistant trainers who are under the guidance of a certified dog trainer. The Master Puppy Program focuses on beginner and advanced behaviors, impulse control, and proper socialization. Structured and organized training adds mass to the pup's learned behaviors so that they will be strong when the pup goes to his new home. From there, the owners have the advantage of a strong training foundation as they continue to build on the pup's training.

SOCIALIZATION: From day one till around 6 months, a puppy is in the Critical Period, so called because of the essential need to properly expose the puppy to the world around them during the puppy's impressionable period. Whatever positive or negative experiences the puppy has during this time will shape the pup's temperament and his future. Using classical conditioning (pavlovian conditioning) and positive reinforcement, the trainer will help the puppy make positive associations to experiences and "cushion" the positive around the puppy to help guard against the possibility of negative experiences having a long term effect. The puppy will be exposed to many different environments and have monitored doggy play dates. Attention will be put towards introducing the puppy to a variety of people, dogs, places, sounds, and textures.

VET VISITS/CARE: The puppy will receive the appropriate veterinary care including first and second shots and rabies, flea and tick treatment, and heartguard. Any other shots or treatments are the Owners decision and will be paid for by the Owner.

Additional fees for vaccinations and veterinarian exams

SIT: The puppy will be taught to have a reliable SIT

DOWN: The puppy will be taught to have a reliable DOWN

DOWN/STAY: Down stay up to 3 minutes and around distraction. Down stay with duration and distance.

Started in transferring Down to real life scenarios: Down during dinner/while preparing food/while at the cash register/etc ..

COME WHEN CALLED: Reliable long distance recall and started in off leash recall with distractions. A unique Recall Cue will be used when calling the puppy.

LOOSE LEASH WALKING: Polite loose leash walking:

No pull

Follow

Automatic sit when at a stop

Return to walker upon a hand signal

Watch Me

Started in non reactive skills to other dogs

CAR MANNERS: Quiet in crate in car/polite car manners/Trained with doggy seat belt/car door waiting upon entering and exiting

HOUSE MANNERS: No jumping on furniture/taught to chew on appropriate items and discouraged from any inappropriate chewing/food bowl waiting/house door waiting

TOUCH: Touch fingers upon verbal cue

NO BEG: No begging while food is being prepared and eaten.

DROP IT: Taught to drop an item upon command

TRICK: At least one trick

CRATE TRAINING: Sleeping through the night in crate with no accidents/Quiet in crate during the day/car crate trained

HOUSE TRAINED: No accidents in crate at night. No accidents in house during the day.

SOCIALIZATION

TRANSFER TRAINING

- Orientation to meet the trainer, her canine family, the puppy, and go over the program.
- Depending on distance, transfer training will be done during the pup's training at the new owner's house, and at puppy take home date (to be decided).
- Depending on the arrangement between the Owner and Trainer, the puppy may spend short intervals at the Owner's home in preparation for the Owners to start syncing up with the puppy's learned behaviors.

NECESSARY SHOTS, WORMING TREATMENT, VETERINARY CARE, FLEA and TICK TREATMENT

The pup will be trained by a certified professional dog trainer. The dog trainer is experienced in not only dog obedience training, but also uses many, often spontaneous, situations as training opportunities. The pup will receive hours of training during this program. Every training outing provides valuable opportunities to take advantage of life happenings and the environment to further train and socialize the pup.

The Trainer and Owner(s) may decide to add on or take off training to better fit the Owner(s) needs, as decided by Owner(s) and Trainer.

The Trainer will provide the Owner(s) with updates on the pup's progress, through tutorial videos and emails.

The Trainer will also provide an overall evaluation letter that explains the pup's unique temperament and any observances made about the pup through the training program.

The Trainer will also provide the Owner(s) with many helpful handouts on getting started and continuing training. A complete guide on how to use the vocal and hand cues will also be provided.
